Projects (Dates subject to change. See map inside).



DISTRICT 1

- 1 Marsh Rd. over U.S. Route 30 Van Wert County**
Overhead construction will require occasional lane closures on U.S. Route 30 during certain phases of the project.
Start: May 2003/Complete: October 2003
- 2 State Route 12 over I-75 Hancock County**
Bridge replacement project on State Route 12 will require lane closures on I-75 during phases of the project. During removal of the existing structure, I-75 through traffic will be diverted over the ramps at SR 12 and no access to or from SR 12 will be permitted. At all other times, SR 12 ramps will remain open, however access over I-75 will not be permitted. Traffic conditions through the zone may be monitored at: www.dot.state.oh.us/dist1/i75.
Start: March 2003/Complete: October 2003
- 3 U.S. Route 30 Paulding/Van Wert Counties**
Pavement repair and resurfacing from the Indiana state line to State Route 49 will reduce traffic to one lane through the work zone.
Start: June 2003/Complete: September 2003

- 4 I-75 Allen/Hancock Counties**
Ramp repair at the interchanges of Bluelick Rd., State Route 696 and Bentley Rd. in Allen County and State Route 103 in Hancock County will require intermittent lane closures on I-75. Closures will occur only during off-peak times. No ramp closures will occur.
Start: Spring 2003/Complete: September 2003
- 5 I-75 Hancock County**
Bridge repair in the north and southbound lanes south of Findlay will require lane closures. Closures will be permitted only from Sunday night until Friday morning during the project.
Start: March 2003/Complete: May 2003

- 6 I-75 Hancock County**
Resurfacing from the County Road 99 interchange to just north of the County Road 109 overpass will reduce traffic to one lane through the work zone. Lane closures will take place during off-peak times.
Start: July 2003/Complete: August 2003

DISTRICT 2

- 7 I-75 Lucas County**
Nighttime resurfacing through Toledo, between I-475 and State Route 25 (Anthony Wayne Trail). No motorist delays are anticipated on I-75.
Start: May 2003/Complete: August 2003
- 8 I-75 Lucas County**
Replacement of the Detroit Avenue (U.S. Route 24) bridge over I-75. No motorist delays are anticipated on I-75.
Start: April 2003/Complete: September 2003
- 9 I-75 Lucas County**
Nighttime bridge painting at Central Avenue (near I-75/I-475 split) may cause delays between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. daily.
Start: August 2003/Complete: October 2003

- 10 I-75 Wood County**
Nighttime paving, between U.S. Route 6 near Bowling Green and State Route 25 near Cygnet, will reduce I-75 to one lane between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Motorist delays are expected.
Start: May 2003/Complete: July 2003

- 11 I-75 Wood County**
Reconstruction of the I-75/State Route 18 interchange near North Baltimore will cause nighttime lane closures on I-75, between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m., throughout the year. Some ramp closures are possible; detour routes will be posted. Motorist delays are expected.
Start: March 2003/Complete: November 2003

- 12 I-280 Lucas County**
Construction continues between I-75 and State Route 2 (Navarre Avenue). Motorists will encounter few daytime lane closures, but nighttime lane closures (7 p.m. - 6 a.m.) are likely. Construction information is available at: www.lookuptoledo.org.
Start: January 2003/Complete: January 2004

- 13 I-475 Lucas County**
Nighttime paving on I-475, between I-75 and U.S. Route 23, will reduce I-475 to one lane between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. Motorist delays are expected.
Start: May 2003/Complete: July 2003

DISTRICT 3

- 14 I-71 Medina County**
Widening and reconstruction from one mile south of State Route 18 to the Cuyahoga county line. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
Start: Summer 2000/Complete: October 2003

- 15 I-71 Richland/Ashland Counties**
Widening and reconstruction from the Richland/Ashland county line to north of U.S. Route 250. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction.
Start: Spring 2000/Complete: April 2004

- 16 I-71 Richland County**
Widening and reconstruction from the Richland/Ashland county line south to the I-71/State Route 39 interchange. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
Start: Spring 2001/Complete: September 2003

- 17 I-71 Wayne County**
Widening and reconstruction from the Ashland/Wayne county line to the Wayne/Medina county line. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: October 2003

DISTRICT 4

- 18 State Route 8 Summit County**
Reconstruction from north of the Central Interchange to the north expressway viaduct (just north of Perkins St.). Reconstruction of some ramps and elimination of other ramps. Service roads will be constructed. One lane of traffic in each direction will occur during non-peak hours. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all other times. Extensive ramp closures will occur during this project.
Start: January 2003/Complete: Spring 2005

- 19 State Route 711 Mahoning County**
Construction of a new four-lane, limited-access divided highway from just north of U.S. Route 422 to I-80/State Route 11 with an interchange at Gypsy Lane. A detour will be provided with minimal impact to U.S. 422.
Start: April 2003/Complete: Fall 2005

- 20 I-76 Mahoning County**
Replacement and widening of two bridges over Lake Milton on I-76. A minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers.
Start: Summer 2001/Complete: October 2003

- 21 I-76 Mahoning County**
Reconstruction of I-76, reconstruction and widening of Bailey Rd. interchange ramps to accommodate a left turn lane and rehabilitation of bridges on I-76 at Newton Falls Rd. and Duck Creek Rd. Two-way traffic will be maintained on I-76.
Start: September 2003/Complete: Fall 2005

- 22 I-76 Portage County**
Rehabilitation from just west of New Milford Rd. in Rootstown to just east of State Route 14 in Edinburg and reconstruction of mainline bridges. A minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers.
Start: September 2003/Complete: Fall 2005

- 23 I-76 Portage County**
Resurfacing and rehabilitation of bridges from just west of County Road 18 for a distance of eight miles east. One lane of traffic in each direction will occur during non-peak hours. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all other times.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: Summer 2004

- 24 I-77 Stark/Summit Counties**
Widening from four to six lanes, three in each direction from the Wayview Rd. overpass to north of the Summit County line. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers. Traffic reduced to one lane at night as needed. Limited ramp closures will occur during night.
Start: Summer 2002/Complete: October 2003

- 25 I-77 Stark County**
Widening from four to six lanes, including bridges, from Orchard Park Rd. to Whipple Ave. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers. Traffic reduced to one lane at night as needed. The U.S. Route 62 westbound ramp to I-77 northbound will be closed from June to October 2003. The I-77 northbound ramp from Fulton Rd. will be closed from June to October 2003. The I-77 northbound ramp to Whipple Ave. will be closed from April to October 2003. The ramp to and from Belden Ave. may be closed at night in September 2003 for approximately 24 days.
Start: Winter 2002/Complete: Fall 2004

- 26 I-77 Stark County**
Widening from four lanes to six lanes, three in each direction between 13th St. to Orchard Park, including the reconfiguration and reconstruction of the U.S. Route 62 interchange. The majority of this project will maintain two lanes of traffic in each direction using median crossovers. Various ramp closures will occur.
Start: Spring 2000/Complete: August 2003

27 I-77 Stark County

Widening and reconstruction including the existing separated crossing with the Norfolk Southern Railroad. Dueber Ave. will be closed for two years. The majority of this project will maintain two lanes of traffic in each direction using median crossovers. Traffic reduced to one lane during nighttime hours as needed. No ramp closures are anticipated.
Start: October 2003/Complete: Fall 2005

28 I-77 Stark County

Shoulder work from Fohl Rd. to Brinker Ave. Various lane and/or shoulder restrictions may occur.
Start: June 2003/Complete: Spring 2004

29 I-77 Stark County

Four-lane resurfacing from Tuscarawas County to the Canton corporation limit, including repair on five bridges. Two lanes open during peak hours; one lane in each direction maintained at all other times.
Start: Winter 2002/Complete: October 2003

30 I-80/State Route 46 Mahoning County

Resurfacing and widening of State Route 46 to five lanes. Relocation of I-80 westbound on/off ramps and curve straightening of the I-80 westbound off ramp. Reconstruction of the bridge on SR 46 over I-80. Two way traffic will be maintained on SR 46 with short-term lane and shoulder closures on I-80 during bridge work and ramp work.
Start: September 2003/Complete: Fall 2005

31 I-90 Ashtabula County

Reconstruction and bridge rehabilitation over Conneaut Creek. A minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: October 2003

32 I-90 Ashtabula County

Reconstruction and realignment from the Lake County line east to Harpersfield Township. A minimum of one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers.
Start: April 2003/Complete: Fall 2004

33 I-480 Portage County

Sign replacement from Streetsboro to the Summit County line. Lane closures will only occur between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. when necessary.
Start: May 2003/Complete: August 2003

DISTRICT 5**34 U.S. Route 33 Fairfield County**

Replace two bridges west of Tarkiln Rd. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using crossovers.
Start: February 2003/Complete: July 2003

35 U.S. Route 33 Fairfield County

Connecting Lancaster bypass and existing U.S. Route 33 near Horns Mill Rd. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction using crossovers.
Start: August 2003/Complete: Summer 2004

36 I-70 Fairfield, Licking, Muskingum and Guernsey counties

Crack sealing between the Franklin and Belmont county line. Intermittent lane closures will occur during night hours, including weekends.
Start: April 2003/Complete: May 2003

37 I-70 Muskingum County

Bridge rehabilitation 2.5 miles west of Zanesville. Intermittent lane closures will occur during night hours.
Start: June 2003/Complete: August 2003

38 I-70 Muskingum County

Bridge painting at the State Route 797 interchange (airport exit). Intermittent lane closures will occur during night hours, including weekends.
Start: May 2003/Complete: September 2003

39 I-70 Guernsey County

Bridge painting one mile west of State Route 723. Intermittent lane closures will occur during nighttime hours, including weekends.
Start: April 2003/Complete: April 2003

40 I-70 Guernsey County

Bridge painting near Old Washington. Intermittent lane closures will occur during nighttime hours, including weekends.
Start: April 2003/Complete: May 2003

41 I-70 Guernsey County

Bridge painting 4.5 miles east of Old Washington. Intermittent lane closures will occur during nighttime hours, including weekends.
Start: May 2003/Complete: June 2003

42 I-77 Guernsey County

Crack sealing between Noble County and Tuscarawas County lines. Intermittent lane closures will occur during night hours, including weekends.
Start: April 2003/Complete: May 2003

DISTRICT 6**43 State Route 315 Franklin County**

Construction of new on/off ramps at State Route 315 and Cannon Drive. Minimal impact to SR 315 traffic. Three lanes of traffic will be maintained during peak hours using temporary pavement. There will be night and weekend lane closures on SR 315.
Start: February 2003/Complete: Summer 2004

44 U.S. Route 23 Franklin County

Nighttime repair and resurfacing from the Big Walnut Bridge to I-270. Crews will continue resurfacing work just north of I-270 to Obetz Rd.
Start: May 2003/Complete: September 2003

45 I-70 Franklin County

Nighttime resurfacing between Broad St. on the west side of downtown Columbus and the I-70/I-71 split. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m.
Start: May 2003/Complete: October 2003

46 I-70/I-71 Franklin County

Nighttime lane closures to replace signs on I-70 from the Rome-Hilliard exit on the city's west side to the I-70/I-71 split. Crews will also be replacing signs on I-71 from I-70 to Fifth Ave.
Start: March 2003/Complete: November 2003

47 I-70 Madison County

Nighttime lane closures for resurfacing and pavement repair from the Madison/Clark county line to U.S. Route 42. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Short-term ramp closures will also occur at U.S. 42 and State Route 56. Lane and ramp closures on I-70 are limited to nights and weekends.
Start: July 2003/Complete: October 2003

48 I-71 Fayette County

Major reconstruction from the Greene/Fayette county line to Jeffersonville. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Road closures on various overpasses will be necessary.
Start: April 2003/Complete: Fall 2004

49 I-270 Franklin County

Pavement rehabilitation, sign replacement and structure repair from Alum Creek Drive to U.S. Route 23 on the south side of Columbus. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction using temporary pavement.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: October 2003

50 I-270 Franklin County

Major reconstruction and shoulder widening on the south side of Columbus from I-71 to just west of U.S. Route 62. The ramp from I-270 south to U.S. 62 will be closed for four months during the project. Other on/off ramps will be closed for shorter periods of time. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction on I-270 during peak hours using temporary pavement.
Start: July 2003/Complete: Fall 2004

51 I-670 Franklin County

Reconstruction and expansion of I-670 from State Route 315 to I-71. I-670 is closed between Neil Ave. and Third St. in downtown Columbus. Motorists are using SR 315 to I-70 to I-71 as a detour for crosstown traffic.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: October 2003

52 I-670 Franklin County

Reconstruction from I-70 to Grandview Ave. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction using temporary pavement.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: July 2003

DISTRICT 7**53 I-70 Clark County**

Widening of four bridges and approximately one mile of pavement to three lanes in each direction at Enon Rd. An 11-foot width restriction is in effect on I-70. Overnight and off-peak hour lane closures will occur on I-70. Traffic is maintained on Enon Rd.
Start: Spring 2002/Complete: August 2003

54 I-70/I-75 Montgomery County

Reconstruction of various interchange ramps and bridges on both I-70 and I-75. Current lanes of traffic will be available during peak travel times.
Start: March 2003/Complete: Spring 2006

55 I-75 Miami County

Widening to three lanes in each direction between Troy and Tipp City. Various lane closures.
Start: Summer 2000/Complete: September 2003

56 I-75 Montgomery County

Construction of a new interchange 1.5 miles south of I-70. Three lanes of traffic maintained during peak travel times. Overnight and off-peak hour lane closures.

Start: Spring 2002 Complete: Fall 2004

57 I-75 Shelby County

Replacement of two bridges over the Great Miami River. Overnight and off-peak hour lane closures.

Start: March 2003 Complete: Fall 2004

DISTRICT 8**58 I-71 Clinton County**

Pavement repair from State Route 73 to U.S. Route 68. Lane closure from 9 p.m. Sunday through noon Friday. All lanes open during the weekend.

Start: July 2003/Complete: November 2003

59 I-75 Hamilton/Butler County

Widening from I-275 to Tylersville Rd. Nightly lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Start: March 2003/Complete: Summer 2005

60 I-75 Warren County

Paving from State Route 122 to the Montgomery County Line. Nightly lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Start: April 2003 Complete: September 2003

61 I-275 Clermont County

Widening from U.S. Route 50 to Beechmont Ave. Nightly lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Start: Spring 2002 Complete: November 2003

62 I-275 Hamilton County

Widening from U.S. Route 42 to Montgomery Rd. Nightly lane closures on I-275 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Start: Spring 2002/Complete: November 2003

63 I-275 Hamilton/Clermont Counties

Repair pavement and bridges from Montgomery Rd. to U.S. Route 50. Nightly lane closures from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

Start: Spring 2002/Complete: July 2003

64 I-675 Greene County

Paving from State Route 235 to the Clark county Line. Nightly lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Start: April 2003/Complete: September 2003

DISTRICT 9**65 State Route 32 Jackson County**

Interchange construction at the intersection of State Routes 32 and 327, south of Wellston. Traffic is being maintained in at least one lane in each direction on SR 32 at all times; SR 327 is closed from the routes' junction to its intersection with County Road 88, and traffic is being detoured from CR 88 to SR 32.

Start: Winter 2002/Complete: July 2004

66 U.S. Route 23 Pike County

A three-mile, four-lane resurfacing project from just north of Waverly at Township Road 413 (Keechle Hill Rd.) to the Pike-Ross county line. Traffic will be maintained in a minimum of one lane in each direction at all times.

Start: April 2003 /Complete: August 2003

67 U.S. Route 23 Pike County

A four-mile, four-lane resurfacing project from the Pike-Scioto County line to AEC/DOE overpass. Traffic will be maintained in a minimum of one lane in each direction at all times.

Start: May 2003/Complete: Spring 2004

68 U.S. Route 23 Ross County

A four-mile, four-lane resurfacing project from County Road 600 (Massiveville Rd.) to the U.S. Route 23/U.S. Route 35 bypass at Chillicothe. Traffic will be maintained in at least one lane in each direction at all times.

Start: Summer 2002/Complete: July 2003

69 U.S. Route 35 Ross County

A new road construction project of a 9.5-mile, four-lane limited access highway to relocate U.S. Route 35 between Chillicothe and Richmond Dale. Traffic will be maintained on the existing U.S. 35 throughout construction; traffic impacts will be minimal.

Start: Summer 2002/Complete: Winter 2004

70 U.S. Route 23 Scioto County

A bridge replacement project of the U.S. Grant Bridge, crossing the Ohio River from Portsmouth, Ohio to South Shore, Kentucky. Traffic is being detoured via the Carl Perkins Bridge, west of Portsmouth.

Start: Summer 2001/Complete: Summer 2004

DISTRICT 10**71 State Route 7 Monroe County**

Resurfacing between Hannibal and Clarington. Traffic will be maintained to one lane during work.

Start: May 2003/Complete: July 2003

72 State Route 7 Washington County

Resurfacing between Newport and New Matamoras. Traffic will be maintained to one lane during work.

Start: June 2003/Complete: August 2003

73 U.S. Route 33 Athens County

Major reconstruction through Nelsonville. Travelers may expect changing traffic patterns throughout project with local detours implemented as needed. Expect delays.

Start: Summer 2002/Complete: October 2003

74 U.S. Route 33 Meigs County

Replacement of the Pomeroy-Mason Bridge. Traffic will be maintained on the current bridge until new bridge is completed.

Start: April 2003/Complete: Summer 2006

DISTRICT 11**75 I-70 Belmont County**

Slip repair in westbound lanes just west of State Route 800. Eastbound lanes will not be affected. One lane of traffic will be maintained.

Start: July 2003/Complete: August 2003

76 I-77 Tuscarawas County

Approximately five miles of four-lane major rehabilitation between the Newcomerstown and Stonecreek exits. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction. Congestion and delays are likely.

Start: March 2003/Complete: Summer 2004

DISTRICT 12**77 I-90 Cuyahoga County**

Nighttime resurfacing and bridge replacements of I-90 from East 55th St. to just east of Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd. At least two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction between 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Start: July 2003/Complete: Fall 2004

78 I-90 Cuyahoga and Lake Counties

Reconstruction and add lane on I-90 from State Route 2 to west of State Route 84. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Start: March 2003/Complete: October 2003

79 I-90 Lake County

Extending I-90 add lane from west of State Route 306 to east of SR 306. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction between 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Start: March 2003/Complete: September 2003

80 I-90 Lake County

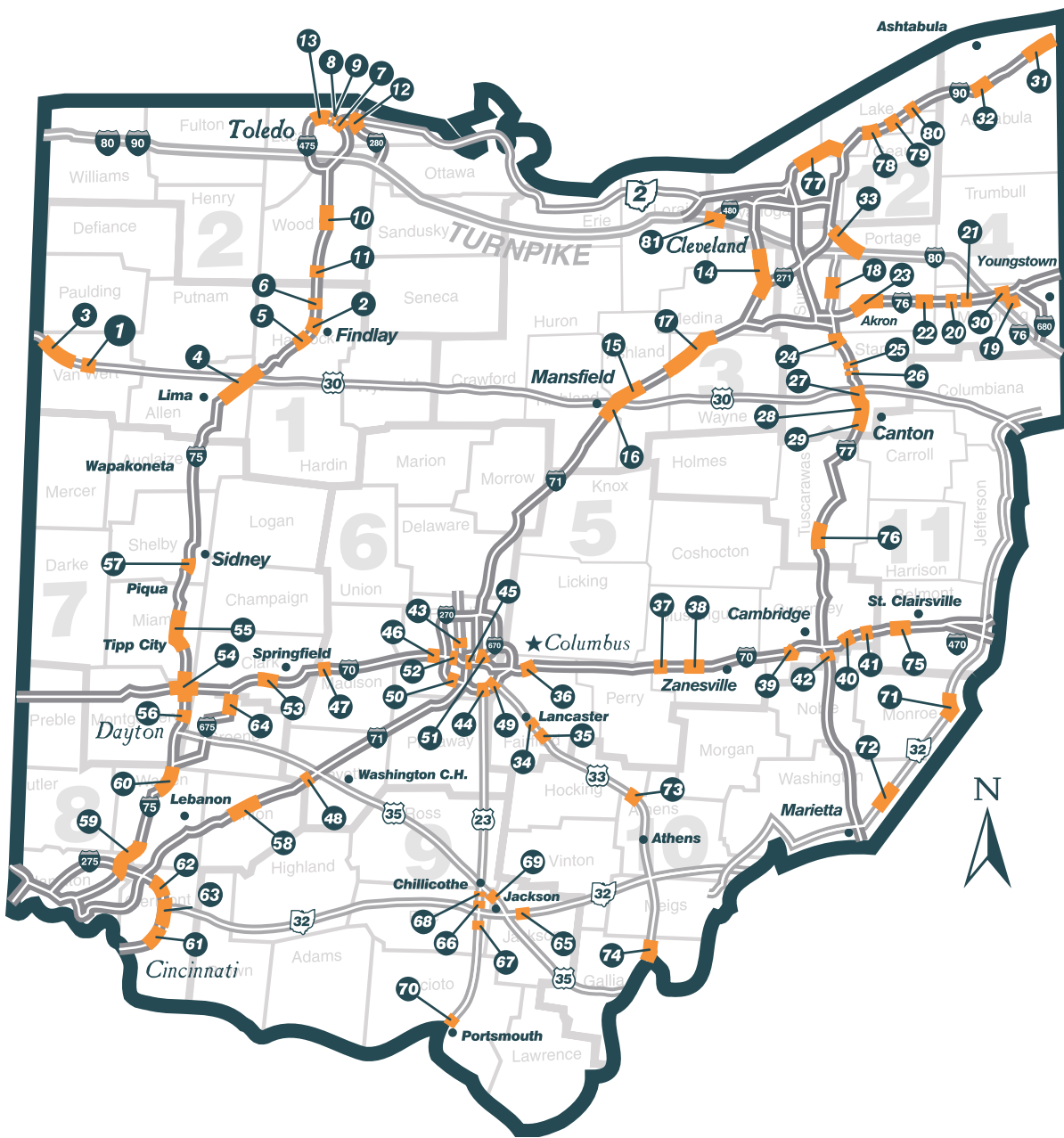
Widening of State Route 615 and the addition of an interchange from SR 615 to I-90.

Start: Summer 2002/Complete: October 2004

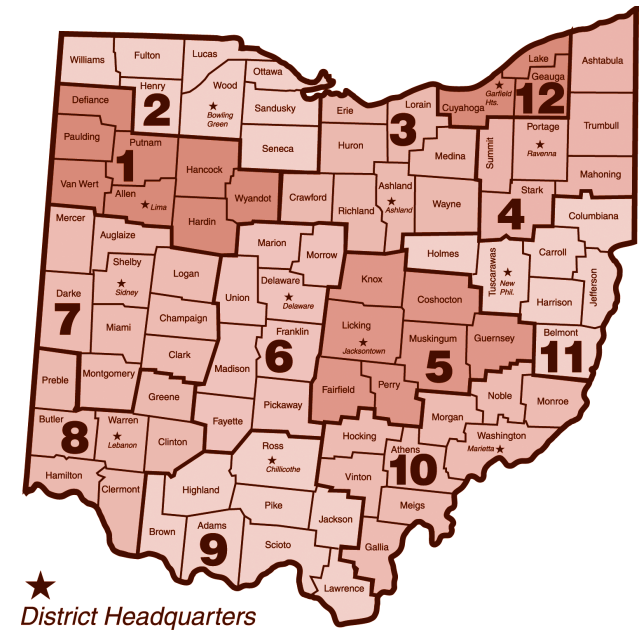
81 I-480 Cuyahoga County

Reconstruction on I-480 from Idlewood Rd. to Tuxedo Ave. Three 10-foot lanes maintained. Lane addition on I-480 east to State Route 176 north.

Start: March 2003/Complete: Spring 2004
