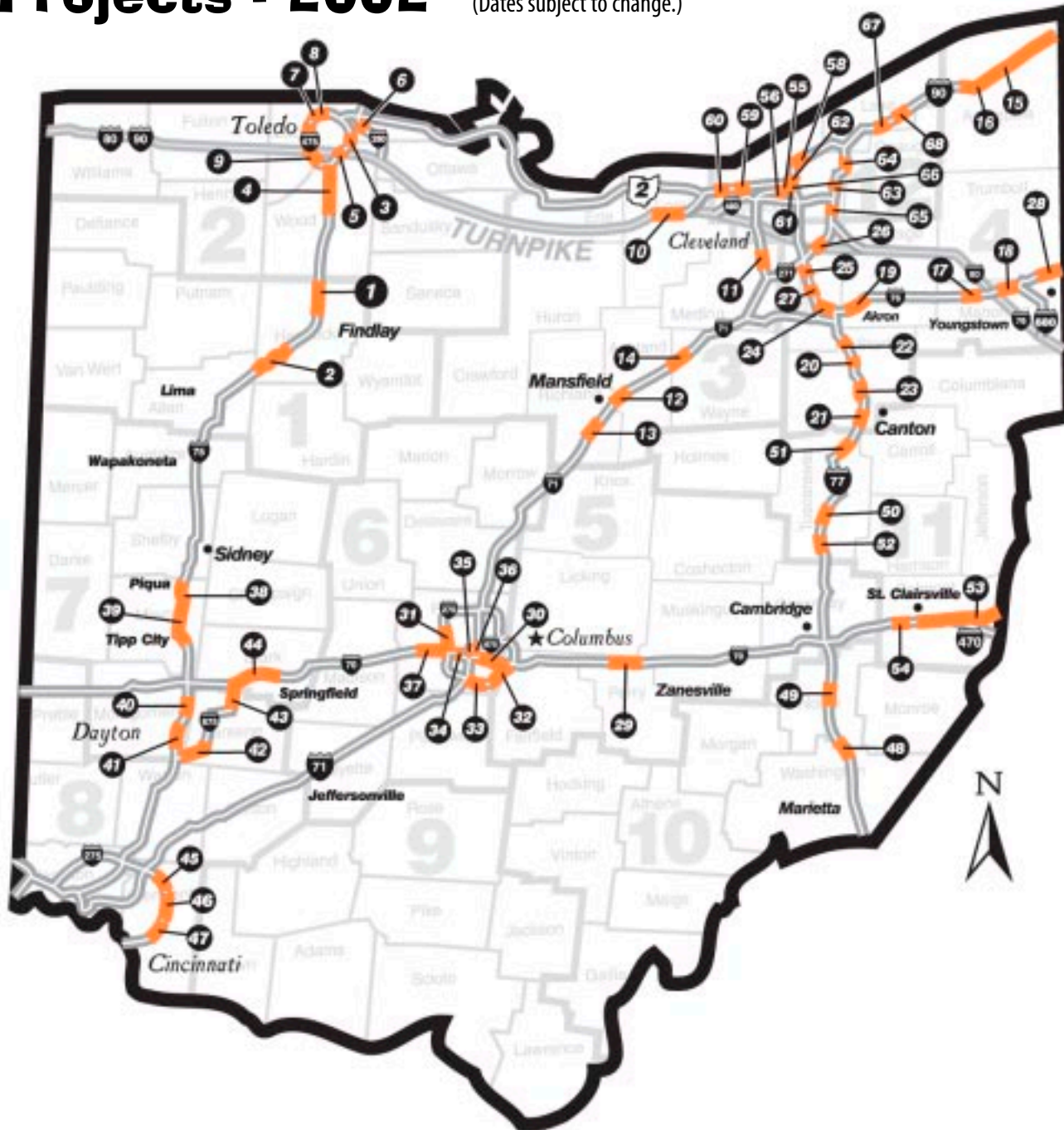


# Ohio Interstate Construction Projects - 2002

(Dates subject to change.)



## District 1

### 1 I-75 Allen/Hancock Counties

Guardrail upgrade from the Auglaize County line to the Wood County line. Intermittent lane closures will occur during off-peak or night hours. Backups should be minimal.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: September 2002**

### 2 I-75 Hancock County

Parking lot repair will close both the north and southbound roadside parks south of Findlay. Each park will be closed from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. for no more than three days during the three-week duration of the project.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Spring 2002**

## District 2

### 3 I-75 Lucas County

Night bridge painting at the I-75/SR 25 (Anthony Wayne Trail) interchange near downtown Toledo.

**Start: February 2002/Completion: May 2002**

### 4 I-75 Wood County

I-75 will be resurfaced at night between SR 25, near Bowling Green, and U.S. 6 near Portage. Motorists should expect delays.

**Start: August 2002/Completion: October 2002**

### 5 I-75 Wood County

The I-75/Buck Rd. interchange near Rossford will be widened and improved. This project will have a minimal effect on I-75 traffic, but will close the Buck Rd. overpass for five months.

**Start: January 2002/Completion: September 2002**

### 6 I-280 Lucas County

Maumee River Crossing - I-280 is being widened to six lanes between the I-75/I-280 interchange and SR 2 (Navarre Avenue). Two lanes of traffic will be maintained during peak travel times.

**Start: January 2002/Completion: June 2006**

### 7 I-475 Lucas County

Various bridges will be painted at night on east and westbound I-475 between the U.S. 23 interchange and Secor Rd. Motorist should expect long delays.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: June 2002**

### 8 I-475 Lucas County

Night resurfacing on I-475 between the I-475/I-75 interchange and the I-475/U.S. 23 interchange. Motorists should expect long delays.

**Start: August 2002/Completion: October 2002**

### 9 I-475 Lucas County

Night resurfacing on north and southbound I-475 between U.S. 24 and Central Avenue (U.S. 20). Motorists should use I-75 and east and westbound I-475 as alternate routes.

**Start: August 2002/Completion: October 2002**

## **District 3**

---

### **10 I-90 Lorain County**

Resurfacing and bridge deck maintenance between I-80 and SR 61. Includes widening and reconstruction from SR 611 to SR 83. Two lanes of traffic maintained in each direction during daytime hours, with limited night lane closures.

**Start: May 2001/Completion: August 2002**

### **11 I-71 Medina County**

Reconstruction from one mile south of SR 18 to the Cuyahoga County line. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.

**Start: June 2000/Completion: October 2002**

### **12 I-71 Richland/Ashland Counties**

Reconstruction and lane addition from one-half mile south of the Richland/Ashland County line to north of U.S. 250. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction.

**Start: May 2000/Completion: October 2003**

### **13 I-71 Richland County**

Reconstruction and lane addition from the Richland/Ashland County line south to the I-71/SR 39 interchange. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.

**Start: April 2001/Completion: September 2003**

### **14 I-71 Wayne County**

Reconstruction and lane addition from the Ashland/Wayne County line to one mile north of SR 539. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction.

**Start: March 2002/Completion: October 2003**

## **District 4**

---

### **15 I-90 Ashtabula County**

Minor bridge repair and painting of eight bridges on I-90 in Ashtabula County in various locations. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be maintained.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Late summer 2002**

### **16 I-90 Ashtabula County**

Reconstruction of I-90 and bridge rehabilitation over Conneaut Creek. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction throughout construction using median crossovers. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained when necessary. Traffic will return to its normal side during the winter months. No ramp closures are expected.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2003**

### **17 I-76 Mahoning County**

Replacement of the existing twin bridge decks and widening of the bridges over Lake Milton on I-76 for additional shoulder width. A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained using median crossovers.

### **18 I-80 Mahoning County**

Resurfacing on I-80 from I-76 (Turnpike) to the Trumbull County line. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained during weeknights and weekends. A minimum of two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all other times.

**Start: October 2001/Completion: Summer 2002**

### **19 I-76 Portage County**

Resurfacing and rehabilitation of bridges on I-76 from just west of CR 18 for a distance of eight miles. One lane of traffic in each direction will occur during non-peak hours. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all other times.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2004**

### **20 I-77 Stark County**

Reconstruction and reconfiguration of interchanges and construction of two additional lanes between 13th St. and Orchard Park, including the reconfiguration and reconstruction of the U.S. 62 interchange. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained using median crossovers with various ramp closures.

**Start: Spring 2000/Completion: Summer 2003**

### **21 I-77 Stark County**

Rehabilitation of existing bridges on I-77 over Brinker St. There will be no lane restrictions on I-77. Brinker St. will be reduced to one lane for three to four months during construction.

**Start: Spring 2001/Completion: Spring 2002**

### **22 I-77 Stark/Summit Counties**

Widen the existing four lanes to six lanes, three in each direction from the Wayview Rd. overpass to the Summit County line. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction using median crossovers. One lane in each direction will be maintained at night when necessary. No ramp closures are expected.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

### **23 I-77 Stark County**

Underground mine investigation and repair on I-77 at Fohl Rd. Various lane and/or shoulder restrictions may occur.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

### **24 I-76 Summit/Portage Counties**

Resurfacing from the eastern Akron corporation limit to the Portage County line. This work also includes the rehabilitation and widening of bridges at SR 532 and Eastwood Ave. Two lanes of traffic in each direction will be maintained using median crossovers. One lane of traffic in each direction will occur at non-peak times. Ramp closures on the eastbound side of I-76 will occur.

**Start: July 2000/Completion: Fall 2002**

### **25 I-77 Summit County**

Replacement of the existing I-77 bridges over Yellow Creek. This project also includes the resurfacing of I-77 from the SR 18 interchange to Everett Rd. One lane in each direction will be maintained during non-peak hours. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained at all other times.

**Start: April 2001/Completion: Fall 2002**

### **26 I-271 Summit County**

Slide repair on southbound lanes of I-271 west of Riverview Rd. Traffic will not be effected.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2002**

### **27 I-77 Summit County**

Redecking and painting various bridges on I-77. A minimum of one lane in each direction will be maintained.

**Start: Fall 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

### **28 I-80 Trumbull County**

Resurfacing of I-80 between Hubbard Township and the Pennsylvania State line, including on and off-ramps and rehabilitation of seven bridges. One lane in each direction will be maintained during weeknights and weekends. Short-term lane restrictions and ramp closures will occur for bridge reconstruction.

**Start: Spring 2001/Completion: Summer 2002**

## **District 5**

---

### **29 I-70 Licking County**

Bridge rehabilitation on I-70 approximately five miles east of the SR 13 interchange. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained at all times in the westbound lanes. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in the eastbound lanes with the exception of a 30-day period between April 15 and May 15, 2002, when one 12-foot lane of traffic will be maintained.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2002**

## **District 6**

---

### **30 I-70 Franklin County**

Night resurfacing on I-70 between James Rd. and the I-70/71 split.

**Start: Spring 2000/Completion: Summer 2002**

### **31 I-270 Franklin County**

Night resurfacing and minor bridge repair from just north of I-70 to U.S. 33 on the west side of the Columbus.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: Fall 2002**

### **2 I-270 Franklin County**

Night resurfacing and minor bridge repair from I-70 to Alum Creek Drive on the southeast side of Columbus.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: Fall 2002**

### **33 I-270 Franklin County**

Pavement rehabilitation, sign replacement, and bridge repair on I-270 from Alum Creek Drive to U.S. 23 on the southeast side of Columbus. Two lanes will be maintained in each direction. Expect delays during peak travel times.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

### **34 I-670 Franklin County**

Reconstruction from I-70 to Grandview Ave. on the west side of downtown Columbus. Two lanes maintained in each direction. Both the Grandview Ave. bridge, between I-670 and McKinley Ave., and the Grandview Ave. ramps will be closed for six months beginning this spring. Motorists will be directed to use the new ramps at U.S. 33/SR 315, which will open in the spring.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2003**

**35 I-670 Franklin County**

Complete reconstruction and expansion of I-670 from SR 315 to I-71. I-670 will be permanently closed between Neil Ave. and Third St. Motorists coming from the west can continue to exit at Neil Ave. and motorists coming from the east can exit at Third St. Crosstown traffic will be detoured onto SR 315 to I-70 to I-71.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

**36 I-670 Franklin County**

Night resurfacing from Cleveland Ave. to I-71.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2002**

**37**

Night lane closures to replace deteriorated signs on I-70 between Rome-Hilliard Rd. and on I-71 between I-70 and Fifth Ave.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Spring 2003**

**District 7**

---

**38 I-75 Miami County**

Reconstruction from one mile north of SR 41 (Troy) to one mile north of U.S. 36 (Piqua). Night and off-peak hour lane closures.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: Fall 2002**

**39 I-75 Miami County**

Widening to three lanes in each direction between Troy and Tipp City. Two lanes maintained in each direction during the day. Periodic restrictions at night.

**Start: Summer 2000/Completion: Fall 2003**

**40 I-75 Montgomery County**

Construction of a new interchange 1.5 miles south of I-70. Three lanes of traffic maintained during peak travel times. Night and off-peak hour lane closures.

**Start: March 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

**41 I-75 Montgomery County**

Bridge replacement over I-75 at Lyons Rd. near Dayton Mall in Miami Township off SR 741. Lyons Rd. will be closed for approximately four months beginning in May. The posted detour is SR 741 to SR 725 to Alexandersville Rd. to Maue Rd.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**42 I-675 Montgomery County**

Resurfacing between I-75 and the Greene County line. Night and off-peak hour lane closures.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: Fall 2002**

**43 I-675 & I-70 Clark County**

Resurfacing between SR 444 and I-70 on I-675. Also, between SR 4 and SR 235 on I-70. Night and off-peak hour lane closures.

**Start: Summer 2001/Completion: Summer 2002**

**44 I-70 Clark County**

Widening four bridges and approximately one mile of pavement to three lanes in each direction at Enon Rd. Night and off-peak hour lane closures on the interstate. Traffic will be maintained with width restrictions on Enon Rd.

**Start: February 2002/Completion: Summer 2003**

**District 8**

---

**45 I-275 Hamilton County**

Widen I-275 from U.S. 42 to Montgomery Rd. Nightly lane closures on I-275 from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

**46 I-275 Hamilton/Clermont Counties**

Repair pavement and bridges from Montgomery Rd. to U.S. 50. Nightly lane closures from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Summer 2003**

**47 I-275 Clermont County**

Widen from U.S. 50 to Beechmont Ave. Nightly lane closures from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

**Start: Spring 2002/Completion: Fall 2003**

**District 10**

---

**48 I-77 Washington County**

Shoulder repair on the southbound side of I-77 at the Macksburg interchange near the Washington County line. No impact to interstate traffic.

**Start: November 2002/Completion: October 2003**

**49 I-77 Noble County**

Land slide repair 1.6 miles north of Belle Valley. Single-lane closures on the northbound side throughout the duration of project.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: August 2002**

District 11

**50 I-77 Tuscarawas County**

Four-lane reconstruction from just south of the Newcomerstown interchange to four miles north to CR 23. One-lane in each direction will be maintained. Motorists should expect delays.

**Start: March 2001/Completion: August 2002**

**51 I-77 Tuscarawas County**

Improvements at the SR 212 interchange in Bolivar. Only the I-77 on and off-ramps and SR 212 will be restricted.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: September 2002**

**52 I-77 Tuscarawas County**

Four-mile resurfacing project from the Guernsey County line to just north of SR 258. Traffic will be maintained in each direction. Impact to traffic will be minimal.

**Start: Summer 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**53 I-70 Belmont County**

Sign upgrade from the U.S. 40 interchange just west of St. Clairsville to the West Virginia state line. Motorists should expect delays.

**Start: March 2002/Completion: June 2002**

**54 I-70 Belmont County**

Bridge repairs from just west of SR 149 at Morristown to just west of SR 331. Traffic will be maintained in each direction. Impact to traffic will be minimal.

**Start: May 2002/Completion: July 2002**

**District 12**

---

**55 I-71 Cuyahoga County**

Resurfacing from the southern Cleveland corporation line to I-90.

Night and off-peak work. Three lanes maintained in each direction will be maintained during peak travel times.

**Start: January 2002/Completion: Spring 2003**

**56 I-71 Cuyahoga County**

Deck replacement on the Fulton Rd. bridge over I-71. Access to all ramps will be maintained with one lane in each direction on the Fulton Rd. bridge over I-71.

**Start: Summer 2001/Completion: Fall 2002**

**57 I-71 Cuyahoga County**

Concrete sealing on eight interstate bridges: Eddy Rd. bridges over I-90; I-271 bridges over Wilson Mills; West 25<sup>th</sup> St. bridges over I-71; I-71 bridges over I-480. Weekend and off-peak lane closures.

**Start: March 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**58 I-90 Cuyahoga County**

Resurfacing of I-90 from the Innerbelt Curve to the eastern Bratenahl corporation limit. Night and off-peak lane closures.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: September 2002**

**59 I-90 Cuyahoga County**

Deck replacement of Valley View Rd. bridge over the Rocky River and MetroParks. Valley View Rd. bridge closed for 90 days. No impact to motorists on I-90.

**Start: July 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**60 I-90 Cuyahoga County**

Addition of a third lane on I-90 from Columbia Rd. to the Lorain County line. Two lanes maintained in each direction. Additional lane and ramp closures will occur during off-peak hours.

**Start: April 2001/Completion: October 2002**

**61 I-90/I-490 Cuyahoga County**

Resurfacing from West 44nd St. to West 7th St. Overnight and off-peak hour lane closures.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: June 2002**

**62 I-90 Cuyahoga County**

Repairs to the Innerbelt and I-71/I-90 eastbound bridges. Over three weekends, two-lane closures are scheduled. On two other weekends, two-lane closures are scheduled. Also, weekend closures of the Ontario Ave. ramp are scheduled.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**63 I-271 Cuyahoga County**

Deck replacement of the Chagrin Rd. bridge over I-271. Night and off-peak hour closures. One lane of traffic maintained on Chagrin Blvd. bridge.

**Start: May 2002/Completion: May 2003**

**64 I-271 Cuyahoga County**

Bridge repair of I-271 bridges over Marsol Rd. I-271 southbound local lanes will be reduced to one lane. Express lanes remain open. Northbound will have two lanes, but shifted over.

**Start: March 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**65 I-480 Cuyahoga County**

Resurfacing of I-480 North from I-480 to I-271. Night and off-peak hour closures.

**Start: June 2002/Completion: October 2002**

**66 I-490 Cuyahoga County**

Resurfacing of the I-490 bridge over the Cuyahoga River valley to E. 55 St. Traffic reduced from three lanes to two lanes and shifted over onto the berm.

**Start: May 2002 /Completion: October 2002**

**67 I-90 Lake County**

Build interchange, reconstruction and lane addition from SR 615 to SR 84. Mid-summer, SR 615 bridge closed for 90 days. Lane closures.

**Start: May 2002/Completion: May 2004**

**68 I-90 Lake County**

Bridge deck replacement of Rockefeller Rd. over I-90. Overnight and off-peak hour closures.

**Start: April 2002/Completion: October 2002**
