Title VI Form

Title VI section of the Civil Rights Act specifically directs that: "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participating in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance."

Title VI and other laws protect four groups against discrimination in federally assisted programs: minorities (Title VI of the Civil Rights Act, 42, U.S.C.), women (23 U.S.C. 324), the disabled (Rehabilitation Act, 29, U.S.C. 794), and the elderly (Older Americans Act, 42, U.S.C. 6102). Also, the Age Discrimination Act of 1975 prohibits discrimination on the basis of age.

(2) Hispanic {a person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race},

(3) Asian American {a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia, the Indian subcontinent, or the Pacific Islands}, or

(4) American Indian or Alaskan Native {a person having origins in any of the original people of North America and who maintains cultural identification through tribal affiliation or community recognition}.
